

Cycling Routes

CHKO Brdy Highlands – Pilská Reservoir

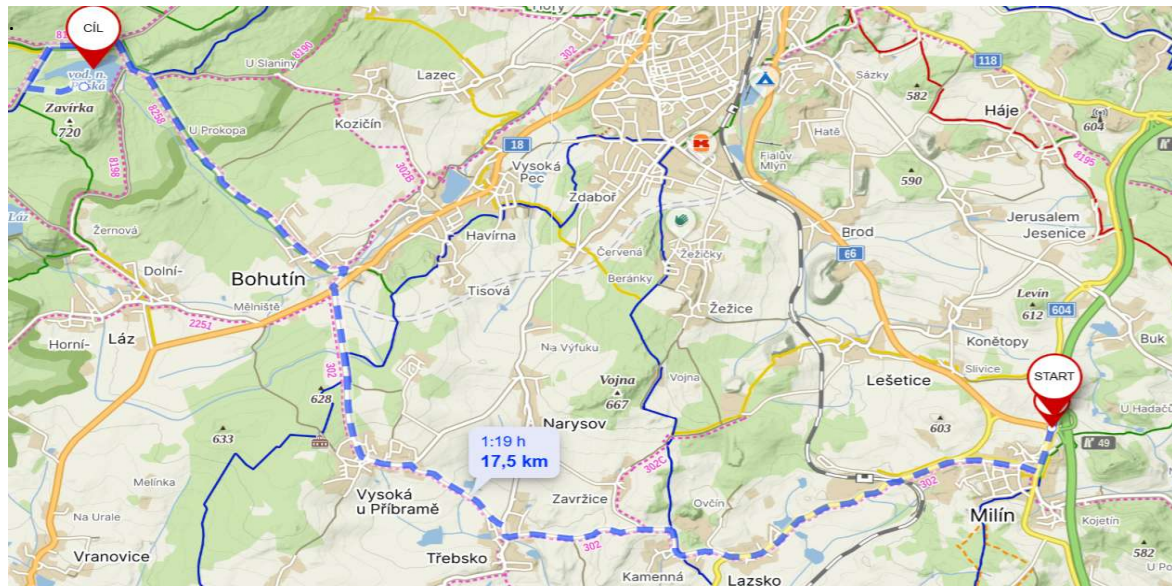
Distance: 17.5 km

Route:

Follow **Cycle Route 302** through the villages of **Lazsko**, **Kamenná**, **Třebso**, and **Vysoká u Příbrami**, where you can visit the **Antonín Dvořák Memorial**.

Continue to the village of **Bohutín**, where we recommend a stop at the popular **Drmlovka Restaurant** for refreshments.

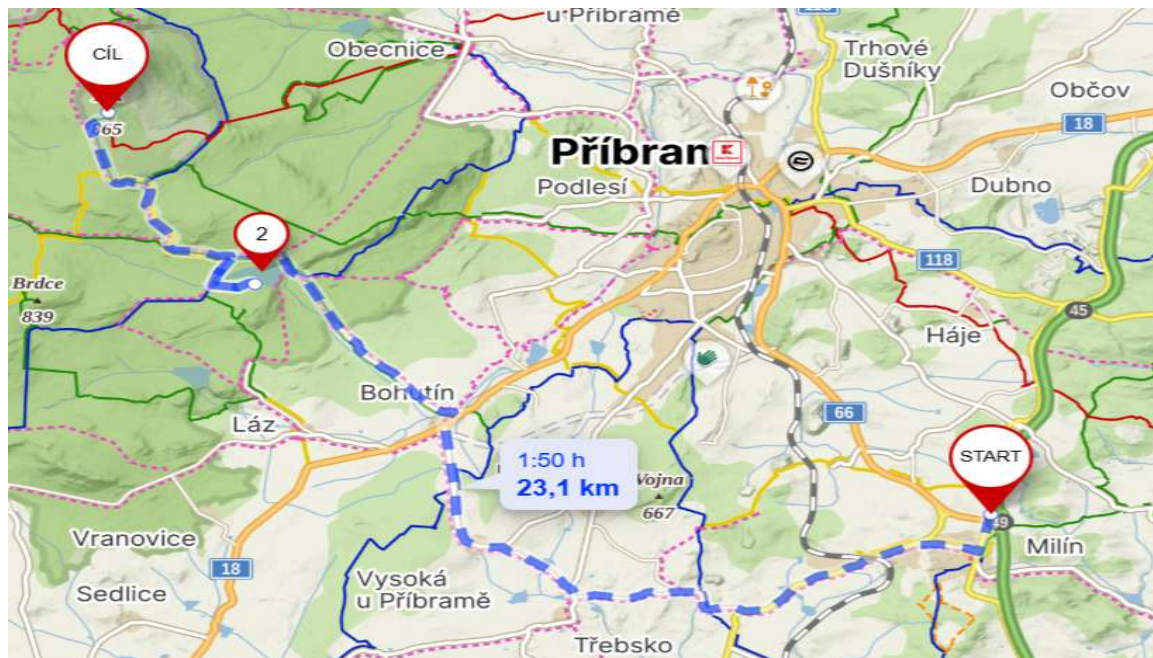
From Bohutín, join **Cycle Route 8258**, which leads through the beautiful forests and unspoilt landscape of the **Brdy Highlands**, taking you all the way to your destination.



The Highest Peak of the Brdy Highlands – Tok

Distance: 23 km

From **Pilská Reservoir**, continue along the same route to **Tok (865 m above sea level)**, the highest peak of the **Brdy Highlands**. The route rewards visitors with beautiful forest scenery, peaceful surroundings, and breathtaking views across the protected Brdy landscape.



Vrškamýk Castle Ruins

Distance: 20.8 km

Route:

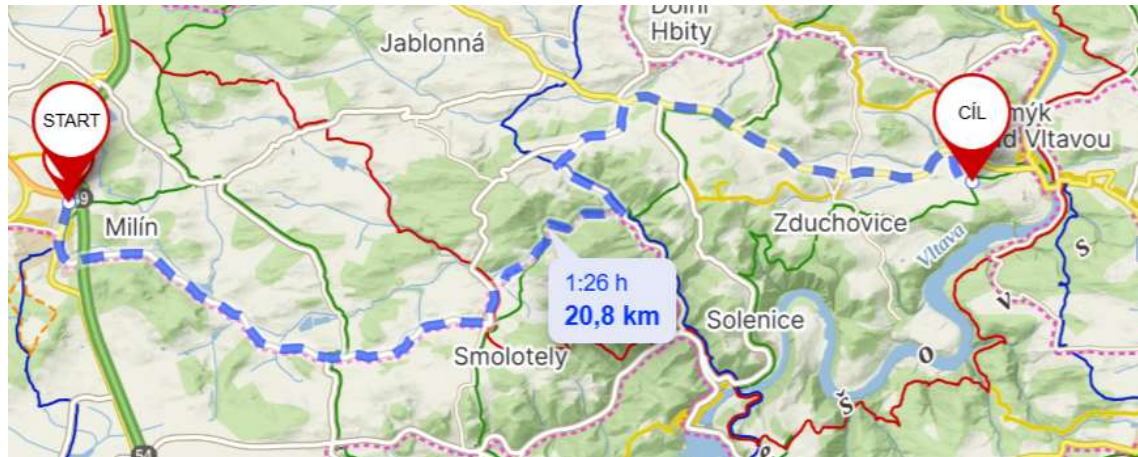
Follow **Cycle Route 302**, this time leaving Milín in the opposite direction towards the villages of **Pečičky** and **Smolotely**.

If you have time for a short detour, we highly recommend visiting **Maková Hora**, a beautiful pilgrimage site featuring a picturesque Baroque church and wonderful views of the surrounding countryside.

Continue through **Panský Mlýn** to **Horní Líšnice**, where you leave the cycle route and follow the local road through the villages of **Žlíbky** and **Brodce** to **Zduchovice**. Here you can visit **Zduchovice Château** before continuing to your destination.

The route ends at the impressive **Vrškamýk Castle Ruins**, where visitors can explore the remains of the medieval castle, enjoy the attractive visitor area, and climb the observation tower for panoramic views.

For those wishing to extend the trip, continue to **Kamýk nad Vltavou**, where you can admire the scenic **Kamýk Reservoir** on the Vltava River.



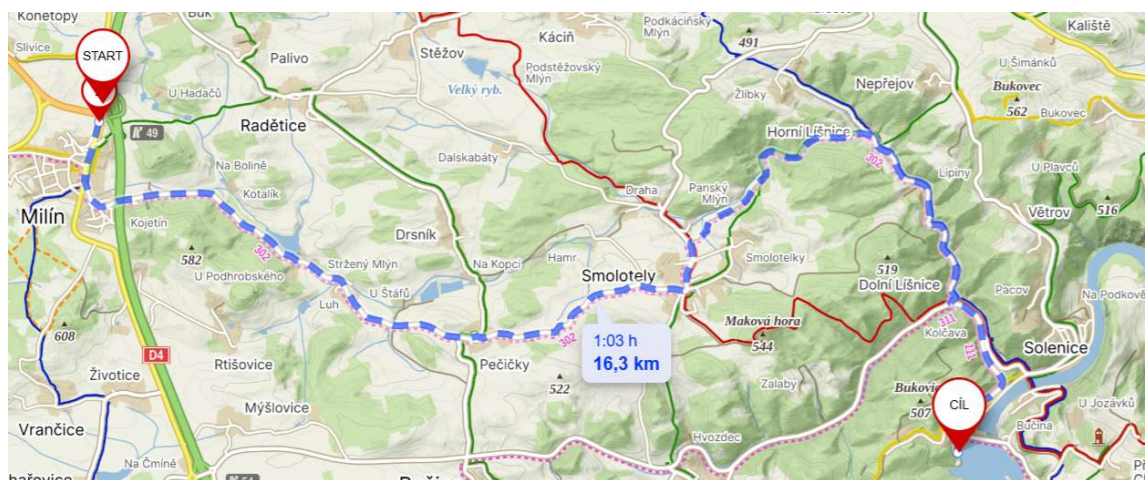
Orlík Reservoir

Distance: 16.3 km

Route:

The first part of the route follows the same itinerary as the ride to Vrškamýk Castle Ruins.

From Horní Líšnice, continue along Cycle Route 302 to Dolní Líšnice, where you join Cycle Route 111. This scenic route leads directly to Orlík Reservoir, one of the Czech Republic's most beautiful destinations for cycling and outdoor recreation.



Březnice Château

Distance: 19.3 km

Route:

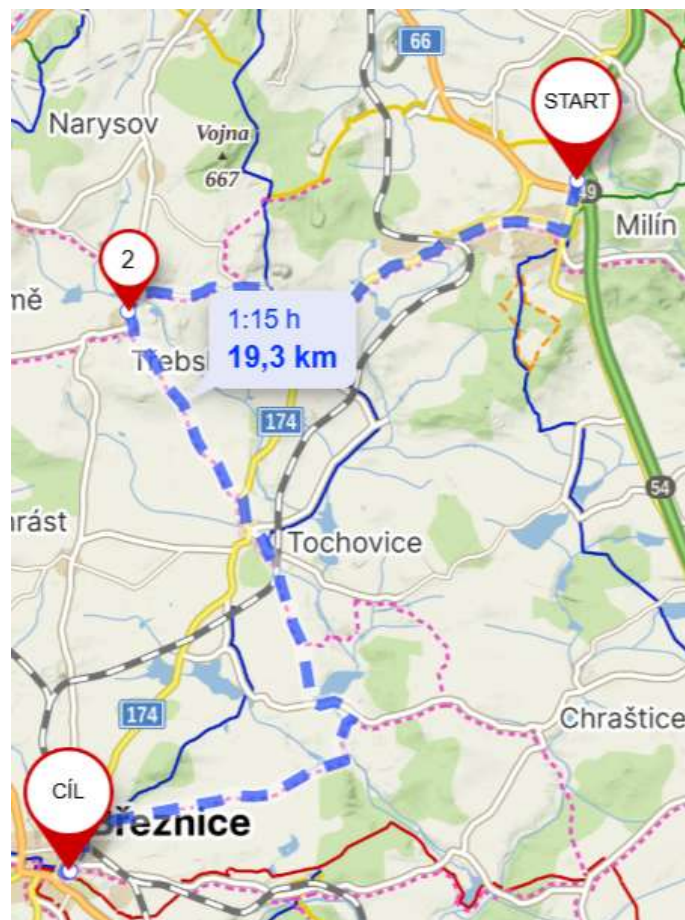
Follow **Cycle Route 302** through the villages of **Lazsko**, **Kamenná**, and **Třebosko**.

In **Třebosko**, join **Cycle Route 8212**, which takes you through the countryside and past a deer enclosure on the way to **Tochovice**.

From **Tochovice**, continue to the village of **Starosedlský Hrádek** and then follow **Cycle Route 8216** towards your destination – the historic **Březnice Château**.

After exploring Březnice, you can conveniently return to **Milín by train**, with the railway connection offering a comfortable alternative to cycling back.

Tip: Visit the beautifully preserved Renaissance interiors of **Březnice Château** and take a relaxing walk through the château park. The historic town centre is also worth exploring.



Full-Day Cycling Tour – Discover the Region's Highlights

Route distance: 37 km

Route:

This full-day cycling tour starts directly from **Hotel U Milína** and takes you through some of the most interesting historical and cultural sites in the surrounding area.

From the hotel, follow the route through **Lazsko** and **Kamenná**, then leave **Cycle Route 302 / 302C** for a visit to the **Vojna Memorial in Lešetice**, an important historical site connected with the modern history of the region.

Return to **Cycle Route 302** and continue towards **Vysoká u Příbrami**, where you can make a short detour to visit the **Antonín Dvořák Memorial** and discover the place where the famous Czech composer found inspiration.

Continue along **Cycle Route 302** through **Bohutín** towards **Příbram – Březové Hory**. Here, follow **Cycle Route 302B** and enjoy a stop at the historic **Miners' House** or take a break at a local pub.

The route continues to the **Březové Hory Mining Museum**, where you can explore the rich mining heritage of the region, followed by a ride through the **Nový Rybník recreational area**.

Join **Cycle Route 8195** towards the famous **Svatá Hora Pilgrimage Site** above Příbram. Continue through the village of **Háje**, where the route connects to the local road **604**, which brings you comfortably back to **Hotel U Milína**.

Tip:

This route is ideal for guests who want to combine cycling with sightseeing. Along the way, you can discover important historical landmarks, enjoy beautiful countryside, and experience the unique character of the Brdy region.
